CELEBRATING THE ADVENT SEASON

December 1 - December 24, 2024

"Immanuel, God with Us: Preparing room in our hearts & minds for the gift of Jesus' presence in our lives."

"Behold, the virgin shall be with child, and bear a Son, and they shall call His name Immanuel," which is translated, "God with us." Matthew 1:23 NKJV



Advent starts at the beginning of the Christian Year, liturgical calendar. The word "Advent" means "arrival." Leading up to Christmas, the Advent Season celebrates Jesus' first arrival and reminds us that He will soon come again (The 2ndAdvent). For the next 25 days, join us as we read the story of Jesus' Birth and remember the promises He came to fulfill (Matthew 1:18 -25 & 1 John 1: 5-9).

For Christians, the four weeks leading up to Dec. 25th are an opportunity to recognize the significance of Jesus' Birth and prepare our hearts and minds for His arrival. The holidays can become hectic, but we have to come to a *Spiritual Mindset* that "Jesus is the Reason for the Season." Slowing down and creating time to spend alone with God must become a daily inward discipline. If we want to have time to reflect on all God has done over the last year and prepare for all He wants to do in the future, we have to make it a priority. Here are three lessons we can learn about Advent from Jesus' Birth:

- 1. **Recognize God's Love.** Out of God's great love for you and me, He sent His Son to earth as a gift for us. Jesus came, lived a perfect life, died on the cross for our sins, and then overcame death. Because of Jesus, we have Forgiveness, Life, Hope, Joy, and Peace.
- 2. Advent is an opportunity to recognize Jesus' Birth and prepare our hearts and minds for His arrival. If we are not intentional about making a place for Jesus in our hearts and minds, the next four weeks of the Advent Season will be gone, and we will not have embraced The true meaning of the Season, "Immanual, (God with Us)." Slowing down and creating time to spend alone with God takes effort. If we want to have time to reflect on all God has done over the last year and prepare for all He wants to do in the future, we have to make it a priority.
- 3. **Celebrate and share the gift of Jesus' presence in our lives.** This Christmas, let us celebrate the gift of Jesus with others. As we gather with friends and family that we haven't seen in a while, let's share with them how the birth of Jesus over 2,000 years ago is still impacting our lives today.

As we light the Advent Candles: *Hope, Peace, Joy, Love,* and *The Christ Candle,* let us demonstrate the transformation in our lives that comes from the work of the Holy Spirit that enables us to recognize the significance of Jesus' Birth and the spiritual impact on believing that God (Immanuel) is with us.
